

Décor Policy

Updated April 17, 2023

Ministry Teams and committees have the authority to participate in the decoration of the church, both inside and outside, as needed in the pursuit of their ministry and/or call. Common sense shall prevail when posting flyers, notices, artwork, etc. in and around the church. The following guidelines are recommended:

Art Installations

Art installations are not to cause the following:

- Marring of the walls or floor
- Block access to rooms and exits
- Impede pathways
- Create an unsafe environment
- Require the movement of fixtures
- No glitter is permitted in the building

Art may be installed using:

- A-Frames
- Easels
- The railings designed to hang photos
- Painter's Tape (blue or purple)
- Floor coverings (that do not create a tripping hazard)

Liturgical Art

The Liturgical Art Team is responsible for liturgical art in and around the church.

Bulletin Board Posting

Sections of the bulletin boards are assigned to specific groups. These groups are responsible for keeping their sections tidy and current.

Class Rooms

Classroom Décor is left to the discretion of the Ministry of Christian Education.

Fellowship Hall

Fellowship Hall Décor is left to the discretion of the Ministry of Hospitality and Fellowship.

Displays deemed inappropriate

Complaints or concerns over any display in and around the church that consider the display as inappropriate may be submitted to any member of the Cabinet. The Moderator and Pastors have final authority in the disposition of any display reported as inappropriate.
