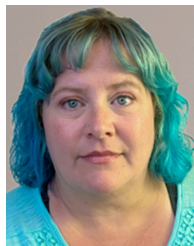

## GROUNDED IN CONNECTION WORSHIP SERIES STARTS JUNE 28

More and more, I've come to believe that our salvation lies in community. I know there are many Christians who would find this heretical. They would say that our salvation lies in Jesus Christ. I would remind them that Paul repeatedly writes about how the body of Christ is the community of believers. The incarnation of Christ continues in community, and if our salvation is in Christ, then our salvation is in community.



That's why I'm going to lead a worship series starting at the end of June on community. Called "Grounded in Connection," this series starts with the recognition that relationships are the cornerstone of who we are as people of faith. Our relationships with others are how we learn and grow. They are the primary way we give and receive love and grace.

During this series, we will explore the joys and challenges of human relationships, community, and

living with one another. In the midst of complex human relationships, we will be reminded yet again that God is here, showing us the way of connection, mercy, and grace. Throughout the series, we will discover we are created to be grounded in connection to God and to one another.

We will have conversation starters on the tables during Coffee Hour, and I'm hoping there will be a couple people who would post and host conversations during the fellowship time on Zoom (if you'd like to be one of those people, please let me know).

We will pause the series on July 12 because worship will be at Quarry Lakes Park that day (see article on page 2), and complete the series during the following three weeks.

I hope this is a spiritually rich worship series for all of you.

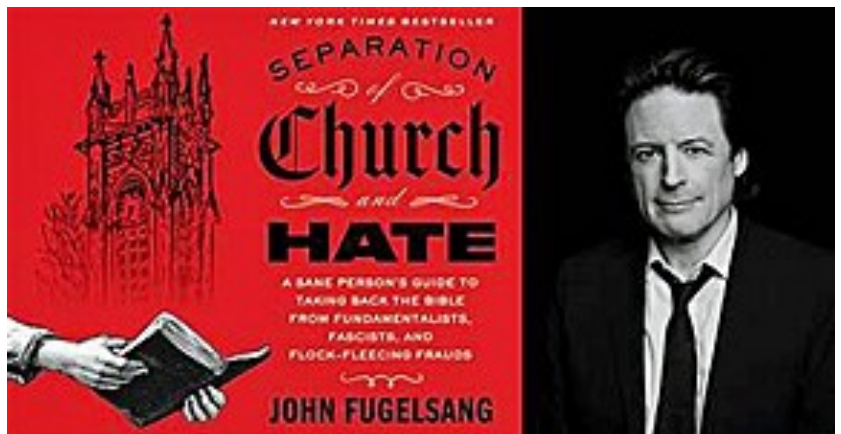
## JOIN THE ALL-CHURCH READ

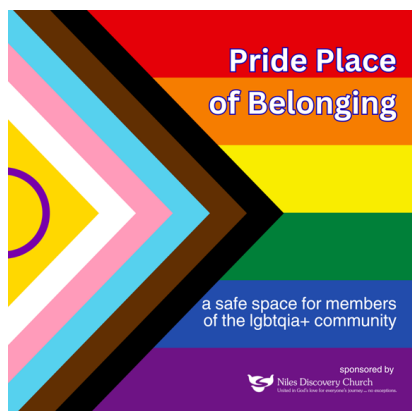

## SEE BOBBY JO VALENTINE IN CONCERT, JULY 19

Hear the award-winning, modern folk singer, storyteller, and poet, Bobby Jo Valentine in concert at Niles Discovery Church, on Sunday, July 19, at 4:00 p.m. Tickets purchased in advance (by 10:00 a.m. on Saturday, July 18) are \$27 online at [bit.ly/bjvndc2026](http://bit.ly/bjvndc2026). Tickets at the door will cost \$30.

Bobby Jo Valentine is an award-winning singer/songwriter who grew up along the windswept coastline of Northern California in a family that attended a Baptist Church. They held “strict lines and sharp edges,” he says. While in many ways it was a nurturing environment, it was also very judgmental about issues of sexuality. This created internal conflicts as Bobby Jo came to realize he is a gay man. He has emerged into a larger, kinder, more welcoming faith ... one that is excited to learn, open to growth, and focused on love.

Now he writes poetic, searching songs that connect deeply with people from all walks of life. His stories are sometimes funny, sometimes moving, and always deeply resonant. Singer/songwriter Dar Williams says, “Bobby Jo has both the spirit and songs to bring us back to believing. Whatever our faith, he has the humor,

compassion, words, and music to help us believe again.”

He is a past recipient of the Songwriter of the Year award at the West Coast Songwriter’s Association, as well as several other awards. His music has been featured in commercials, feature films, wedding ceremonies, and his greatest honor – YouTube videos with puppies. His songs have been sung by choruses around the country, including the San Francisco Gay Men’s Chorus and the Turtle Creek Chorale.



Stephen Schwartz, creator of the musicals *Godspell* and *Wicked*, says Bobby Jo writes “catchy songs with good tunes and intelligent, thoughtful lyrics in the tradition of Bob Dylan, Cat Stevens, and Bruce Hornsby.”

Bobby currently hails from Portland, Oregon, and is ecstatic any time he can discuss the big questions, challenge the easy answers, and inspire people to move closer to love.

A recent audience member told Bobby Jo, “You’re like a mix of John Prine and Mr. Rogers.” Bobby Jo was happy to receive this compliment.

The Fremont Pride Fair will be celebrating the LGBTQIA+ community, families, and allies on Saturday, June 13, 2026, from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. Every year, the



fair features more fun activities for all ages, supportive information for the Queer community, and great joy. The activities range from arts and crafts, games, music, drag story time, poetry, Queer advocacy, giveaways, rainbows, food trucks, supportive conversations, and colorful photo ops. Please plan a visit to the Pride Place of Belonging booth and around 20 other booths at the Fremont Main Library on

Stevenson Boulevard.

This year, the Pride Place of Belonging booth will feature collage making with a “Belonging” theme, and conversations sparked by Queer Trivia cards. We still need helpers to set up at 9:30 a.m., staffing between 10:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m., and clean-up at 2:00 p.m. Volunteers can server a 2-hour shift or stay most of the day to enjoy jaunts around the fair to check out the activities. There are options for extroverts, introverts, organizers, artists, strong people, kid people, conversationalists, and/or friendly people. If you would enjoy doing any one of the these jobs, please sign up.

# DONATION/RECYCLING OF LIGHTLY USED CLOTHING

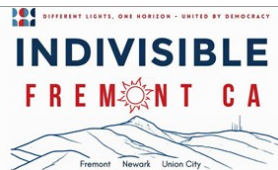
For well over a decade, the Ministry of Social Concerns Team, on behalf of the Niles Discovery Church, and in cooperation with the Tri-City Volunteers, has operated a lightly used clothing donation/recycling program. Lightly used/good quality clothing collected by the church was made available to the community via the Tri-City Volunteers' used clothing store. Tri-City Volunteers curtailed their clothing distribution program during the Pandemic.

With the closure of Tri-City Volunteers' clothing program, the Ministry of Social Concerns Team/ Niles Discovery Church established an informal clothing distribution partnership with the Decoto-based (Union City) Centro de Servicios. The Centro is a long-time community-based organization providing a multitude of services to the heavily Hispanic & immigrant communities of Union City.



The Ministry of Social Concerns Team, in cooperation with the Green Team, is considering sponsoring a used clothing drive in the near future. In the meantime, lightly used/good quality clothing can continue to be donated via the Clothing Donation barrel located in the church fellowship hall.

## LAP ROBE TYING GROUP June 24

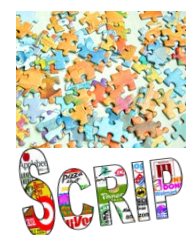
